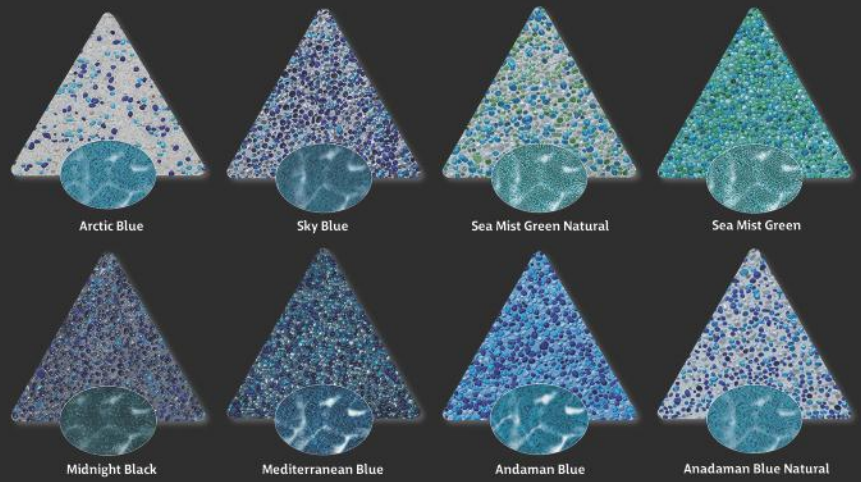

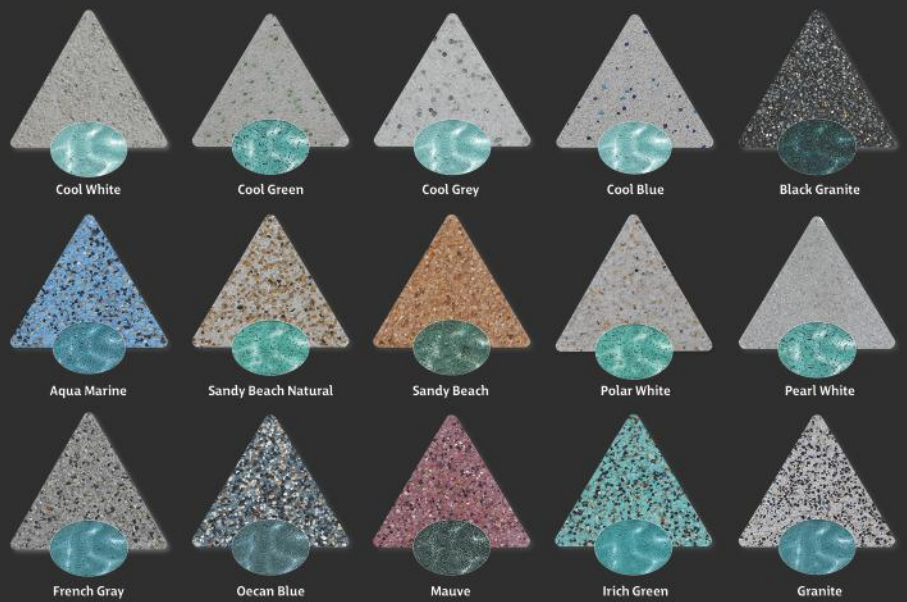


PebbleCrete
